In 2017, Jerry Trevino was appointed to represent the **United Association (UA)** in WHPA. Trevino is the Director of HVACR for the District Council 16, which is an active member of the UA.

In 1996 he completed the Local Union 250 Five-Year Apprenticeship Program and began specializing in direct digital controls, variable speed drives, and centrifugal chiller teardown/overhauls.

For over 19 years, he taught the Journeyman Centrifugal Chiller and Absorber Teardown Class, the Fifth Year Apprentice Advanced Troubleshooting Class, and the Journeyman Core 1 and Core 2 classes.

In 2016 he became the Local Union 250 Organizer. Then in 2017, he was appointed the District Council 16 Director of HVACR Service. In addition, he currently serves as a trustee on three Boards and three Joint Apprenticeship Committees.
