Ms. Lorraine White represents the **California Energy Commission (CEC)** and is the Manager of the Standards Compliance Office in the Energy Efficiency Division.

Rejoining the CEC in August 2018, Lorraine manages staff and activities to develop and implement compliance, enforcement, outreach and educational programs for building standards, and other energy efficiency programs in California with the building industry, local governments, and the general public regarding building standards and building retrofits.

Prior to her current position she was the Program Manager for GEI Consultants' Water-Energy Program and Chair of GEI's Corporate Sustainability Program. She worked closely and collaboratively with clients to successfully complete projects and achieve client objectives. As a member of the corporate risk management committee and chair of the risk management training subcommittee, she was responsible for identifying potential project and company risks and implementing risk reduction strategies. She scoped and prepared proposals, organized project teams, established successful approaches, and prepared cost proposals.

Before joining GEI, Lorraine worked 20 years for the CEC. She managed the \$36 million California Cash for Appliance Program, was the Commission's expert on the relationship between the water and energy sectors, represented the Commission as a member of DWR's 2009 State Water Plan Update Steering Committee, and was a member of the Water-Energy Subgroup to the Governor's Climate Action Team. She managed 2006-07 Integrated Energy Policy Report proceeding, producing the state's primary energy policy document.

Ms. White has held positions as a water resource analyst and project manager in the CEC's power plant siting regulatory program and energy program, as a policy analyst, and as an energy policy advisor to former Chairman Jackalyn Pfannenstiel and to commissioners Anthony Eggert, Dr. Michal Moore, and Dr. David Rohy. Previously, she was a legislative analyst for California Assemblywoman Marguerite Archie-Hudson and Assemblyman Phil Isenberg.

Ms. White holds a BS in Biochemistry from University of California at Davis and was a California Assembly Fellow. She also is certified as an Envision Sustainability Professional by the Institute for Sustainable Infrastructure.
